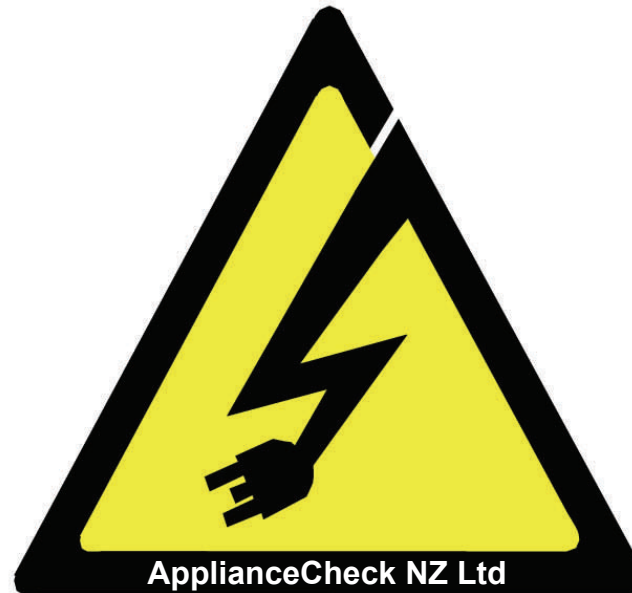


Did you know that:

- ⚠️ 1,200 fires are started every year from electrical fault*
- ⚠️ 60 people a year are directly injured by electrical accidents**
- ⚠️ 5 people die every year from electrocution**
- ⚠️ In case of an electrical accident in the workplace OSH could use non-compliance with standard AS/NZS 3760 as the basis for a prosecution
- ⚠️ Any piece of equipment that is powered by electrical energy and that can be plugged into a wall socket needs testing
- ⚠️ Builders appliances must be tested every 3 months

What is appliance testing?

The government has deemed electricity a serious danger to the public and recommends that all businesses test their portable electrical appliances (any electrical item with a 2 or 3 pin plug) on a regular basis.



Why test?

As an employer you have a statutory obligation to provide a safe work environment, therefore compliance with government standard AS/NZS 3760 is the minimum safety level businesses should meet.

OSH

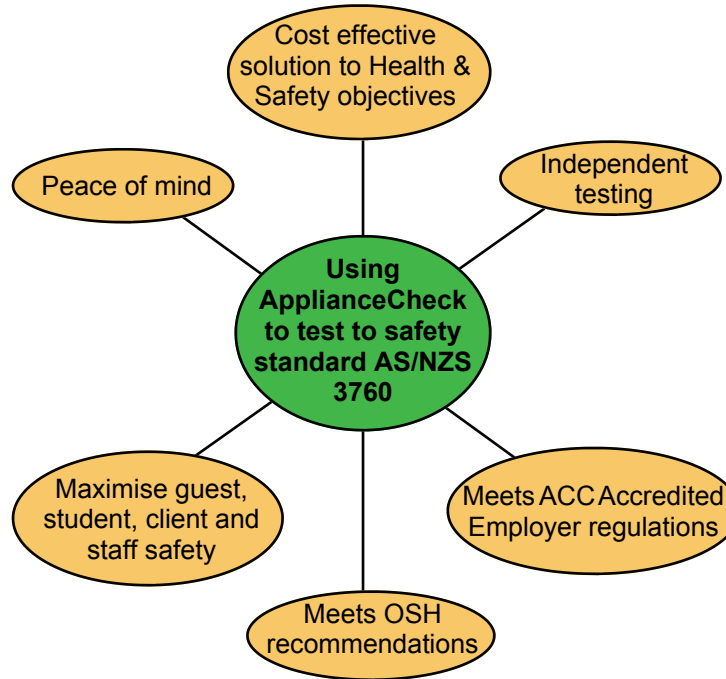
It is not uncommon to fail 5%-15% of appliances tested. If an electrical accident were to occur OSH could use non compliance with AS/NZS 3760 as the basis for a prosecution. Penalty structures exist up to \$100,000 under the electricity regulations.

ACC

All organisations in the ACC Accredited Employer Partnership Program must be testing to AS/NZS 3760 level as part of their health and safety policy.

Achieving Safety Standard

AS/NZS 3760



Test time frames:

3 months	Building and construction equipment, RCDs
6 months	Commercial cleaning & kitchen appliances
12 months	General appliances in the workplace
2 years	Hotel / motel rooms
5 years	IT equipment - computers, printers, faxes, etc.

Who needs to test?
